ANNUAL MEETING OF MEMBERS

The NRA Bylaws (Article IV, Section 2) require any Director, officer, or employee of the Association, who is also a member of the governing body of any business, corporation, or other entity (whether as Trustee, Director, sole-owner, officer, partner, or the like), that does any business with the Association within a year in excess of \$2,000 to file a statement about such business with the Secretary.

I am required to transmit this information to the Board of Directors, which was done in January, and to also inform the members at the next Annual Meeting of Members.

In compliance with Article IV, Section 2, of the NRA Bylaws, the following members of the Board of Directors reported that they have done business with the Association in excess of \$2,000:

- Mr. William Bachenberg's company, DBSi, received \$49,320 for 2011 from the NRA, for providing disaster recovery services for NRA's Information Services Division.
- Mr. Ronnie Barrett's company, Barrett Firearms Manufacturing, Inc., paid the NRA in excess of \$2,000 for advertising and exhibit hall space at the NRA Annual Meetings & Exhibits.
- Mr. Pete Brownell's company, Brownells, received \$14,337 in membership commissions from NRA. Brownells, paid the NRA in excess of \$2,000 for exhibiting at the annual meeting; advertising on Guns and Gold TV; sponsorship fees for NRA Life of Duty, Voice of Freedom, NRA-ILA and the National Police Shooting Championships.
- Mr. Dave Butz receives \$12,500 a month from the National Rifle Association as an independent contractor.
- Ms. Marion Hammer, Executive Director of Unified Sportsmen of Florida, did business with the NRA in the amount of \$122,000 for 2011.
- Mr. Steve Hornady's company, Hornady Manufacturing Company, paid the NRA in excess of \$2,000 for advertising and marketing services provided by the NRA Publications Division.
- Mrs. Clea Mitchell's law firm, Foley & Lardner, LLP provided services related to the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 as amended, and compliance with the rules of the US House of Representatives and United States Senate, and other applicable law related to not-for-profit advocacy organizations. The amount billed to the NRA by Foley & Lardner, LLP in 2011 is \$8,537.00.
- Mr. Ted Nugent received \$50,000 plus travel expenses for a spoken presentation at the 2011 NRA Annual Meetings & Exhibits. The NRA Freedom Action Foundation contracted with SpiritWild Productions to air a 30 second commercial spot on Ted Nugent's Spirit of the Wild TV television show, for an amount of \$40,000.
- Mr. Lance Olson receives \$7,500 a month from the National Rifle Association as an independent contractor.
